How do you apply to become a student radiographer/sonographer at Diagnostic Radiological Services?

Step 1: Spend at least a day at any x-ray department to experience what a day in the life of a radiographer/sonographer entails to ensure that you have made the correct decision choosing radiography/sonography as a career. On the day of your visit please ask for a letter of attendance.

Step 2: Apply timeously for entrance to BRad in Radiography or Ultrasound at the University of Johannesburg. Applications open on the 1st April.

Step 3: On receipt of a letter from the University of Johannesburg stating that you have been provisionally accepted you have to apply at a training institution as well. A list of accredited training institutions will accompany your provisional letter of acceptance.

Step 4: Send your application to us:

Your application has to include the following documents:

- ✓ Provisional acceptance letter from UJ
- ✓ CV
- ✓ Your latest academic results (grade 11 or 12)
- ✓ A letter giving proof of attendance at any x-ray department.
- ✓ Motivational Letter

Step 5: Wait for our call. We will contact you to arrange an interview during September or October.

Step 6: If your application has been accepted we will contact you and provide you with a letter of acceptance for submission to the University of Johannesburg.
